IMO ACHIEVEMENTS - GPs

- + IMO Agreements on Social Welfare Certification (1998 and 2001) – Increase in total payments to GPs from €2.54 million per annum in 1997/98 to €21.7 million per annum in 2003/04,
- + Influenza/Pneumococcal Vaccine Agreement 2000 – Valued at in excess of €10 million per annum
- + GMS Agreement (April 2001) – Increased Nursing and Secretarial Allowances and other measures – Valued at in excess of €15 million per annum,
- + Over 70's GMS Agreement 2001 – Valued at in excess of €75 million per annum,
- + GMS Agreement 2002 – Annual payment of €10 million in respect of Discretionary Medical Cards.
