Dear Colleagues

I refer to the On Call Off Site Payment applicable to above grades in respect of provision of this service for a weekly period under HSE HR Circular 021-2009. The On Call Off Site payments (under HSE HR Circular 021-2009) which were based on a 128 hour period, are now based on a 126 hour period.

The weekly on call period, which incorporates later start times, is as follows:

Monday	5.30 pm to 9am
Tuesday	5.30 pm to 9am
Wednesday	5.30 pm to 9am
Thursday	5.30 pm to 9am
Friday	5pm to 9am
Saturday	9am to 9am Sunday
Sunday	9am to 9am Monday

The applicable weekly payment for this is €576 and the amended hourly on call off site rate is €4.57.


